This saying, which is found in a broad variety of lands, does not arise from the brash worldly wisdom Psalm117 1) The Unpredictability of Life of an incorrigible. It instead reveals deep Christian insight. At the beginning of a new year, many people have nothing better to do than to make a list *Prayer of Approach of bad deeds and resolve from now on-how many such 'from-now-ons' have there already been!—to begin with better intentions, but they are still stuck in the middle of their paganism. They believe that a good intention ***Songs of Praise** already means a new beginning; they believe that on their own they can make a new start whenever they want. But that is an evil illusion: only God Immortal, Invisible, God Only Wise can make a new beginning with people whenever God pleases, but not Blessed Be Your Name people with God. Therefore, people cannot make a new beginning at all; they can only pray for one. Where people are on their own and live by their own devices, there is only the old, the past. Only where God is can there Scripture Reading be a new beginning. We cannot command God to grant it; we can only Psalm 90 pray to God for it.
