Jesus turns our idea of greatness on its head...
and nudges us to gratitude.

1. We can find greatness in status over people who just don't
matter to us... V. 43 - 48

.... Jesus values those who don't matter! (like us!)
How will you respond to Jesus' valuing you?
Gratitude of life?

2. We can find greatness in significance over those we don't
agree with...V. 49 - 50

...Jesus gives the benefit of the doubt and draws
outsiders into his circle (like us!)
How will you respond to Jesus' taking you into his family?
Gratitude of life?

3. We can find greatness in superiority over our "enemies" by
judging them... V. 51 - 56

... Jesus endured injustice and gives out mercy
and compassion to enemies (like us!)

How will you respond to Jesus' compassion and mercy to you?
Gratitude of life?
