## Quotes

That is the meaning, then, of Jesus' "Promise of Power" mentioned in verse 20 in Matthew's form of the Great Commission. In verse 18 the Lord announces that all authority in heaven and earth is his. In verse 20 he says that he will be with the disciples "all the days till the end of the age."

There is a connection between the legal enthronement and the dynamic enabling. Because Christ has won the legal victory over sin, death, and Satan and has been enthroned in power, he has the right to commission the church to go with the gospel through his enabling presence. His promise to be with us till the end of the age is no mere pat on the back to say that he will be with us at a distance, with the energizing power supplied by ourselves. No, never! He is saying that in all our work he will be secretly working by his own inward presence in our lives, taking away our fears, giving us love for the lost, enabling us to forgive our enemies and friends, and giving us a fervent trust in the power of the gospel to bring [people] to faith and eternal life.
