"New Testament Christianity is essentially response to the revelation of the Creator as a God of love. God is a tripersonal Being who so loves ungodly humans that the Father has given the Son, the Son has given his life, and Father and Son together now give the Spirit to save sinners from unimaginable misery and lead them into unimaginable glory. Believing in and being overwhelmed by this amazing reality of divine love generates and sustains the love to God and neighbor that Christ's two great commandments require (Matt. 22:35-40). Our love is to express our gratitude for God's gracious love to us, and to be modeled on it (Eph. 4:32-5:2; 1 John 3:16)."

"Jesus...is talking about loving all true Christians. And this is a command that has two cutting edges, for it means that we must both distinguish true Christians from all pretenders and be sure that we leave no true Christians outside of our consideration. But we must be careful of the opposite error. We must include everyone who stands in the historic-biblical faith whether or not he or she is a member of our own party or our own group. But even if a person is not among the true Christians, we still have the responsibility to love that one as our neighbor. So we cannot say, "Now here's somebody that, as far as I can tell, does not stand among the group of true Christians, and therefore I don't have to think of him any more; I can just slough him off." Not at all. That one is covered by the second commandment."
