The church at Sardis comes under the most severe denunciation of the seven. Apparently untroubled by heresy and free from outside opposition, it had so completely come to terms with its pagan environment that although it retained the outward appearance of life, it was spiritually dead. Like the fig tree of Mark 11:20, it had leaves but no fruit.

Sardis enjoyed a good reputation, but it did not deserve this reputation. Whereas in Pergamum and Thyatira a small element of the congregation had fallen into the temptation of the world, in Sardis the congregation as a whole had "defiled its garments" . . . Sardis was a very peaceful church. It enjoyed peace, but it was the peace of the cemetery!

Perhaps the names in the book are intended to be viewed from the perspective of apparent confession. Those to be "erased" were considered for a time by the church community as those who would receive the inheritance. Their claim to faith was taken at face value for a time because they played the part. Their purported place in the "book of life" will be revealed as a sham when they find at the last judgment that their names are, after all, not in the book. The "erasing" may express this idea. The counterfeit character of people in the church will be revealed in the last day when they do not receive the final reward.
