## **Quotes and Notes**

"A biblical term used in reference to the unapproachable and mighty manifestation of the immediate presence of God. The biblical concept of glory carries with it connotations of inexpressible beauty and majesty. At the same time it implies an absolutely pure and terrifying "holiness" confronting the sinfulness of humans. In the NT, Christ is said to be the glory of God, although a glory that is at least partially veiled from sight, except for those who exercise faith in Christ. Christ's glory is especially a consequence of his resurrection from the dead and his ascension to the right hand of the Father."
