What does it mean for us to gather to worship?

Worship means declaring the worth of God as Creator and Redeemer, seeing what He is worth and giving that to Him. In worship, the affections of our hearts are pulled off of our idols and placed back where they belong, upon the Lord. This involves the whole person - the mind, the emotions, and the will. As we gather together for corporate worship, we do this not just as individuals but as part of a larger assembled body. In this, we humbly recognize three things. First, we were made to worship the Lord. Second, we were made for relationship and reliance upon one another. And, third, that this is a time of response to the Lord's initiative in our lives, calling and stirring us to come to Him.
