"Here the key word is faithful (21, 23). The master has gone into a far country, and will return (14). He has given talents to his servants to trade for him in his absence. These are not abilities (a talent is a weight, which later became a large unit of money). They are, rather, the responsibilities the Lord gives his people in the light of their abilities and opportunities. So it is not a 'talent' in the way we would use the word. It is not a gift, as if we control it. It is not an ability, of which we might boast. It is actually an investment which the Master makes in us his servants. He wants to be able to rely on us in its use."

"The Lord watches what people do with their talents. Some bury them. That is, they keep them for themselves. For them, the Lord is a judge. The talent is removed and the servant sent away. But true servants use their talents. Out of love for God, we set to work. When we are done, we hand the results to him. We will find that he is generous in his rewards. What then shall we say? It is in our heart to search ourselves and find the ways we can use our talents. Deep down, we want to be generous as the Lord is generous to us."

"It is also our duty to stay in the place where we can use our talents or to seek the places where we can serve. If in doubt, start with two questions: Where do you want to serve? Where are wise people asking you to serve? Then find a place, alongside the many who serve the Master, as we await his return."
